Job Overview:

The Seniors Hub Community Programmer will work with the Director of Seniors Program/Food Initiatives and the seniors staff team to achieve the goals and objectives of the hub: to build capacity and support leadership roles of seniors from all cultural backgrounds; build the capacity of seniors' serving organizations to collaborate and expand scope of services and create new opportunities for seniors to participate in community life. The Seniors Hub Community Programmer will work under the direction of the Director to build the capacity of volunteers, develop programs and address emerging needs identified through the Seniors Hub Council.

Specific areas of responsibility include:

- 1. Oversight of seniors driven peer-led community programs including English Conversation Circles, a South Asian Seniors Wellness Group, Move, Groove and Improve Active Aging Circles, Cantonese Wellness & Indoor Exercise
- 2. Working collaboratively within the SVNH Seniors and Food staff team to ensure integrated management and training of volunteers.
- 3. Coordinating the volunteer Information and Referral program.
- 4. Integrating management of volunteers including orientation, training, coaching, coordination and recognition.
- 5. Evaluation of volunteer led programs
