Key Responsibilities:

- Supervise shopping shuttle volunteers during outings
- Collect payment and tickets from passengers
- Fuel vehicle on a regular basis
- Complete daily pre-trip vehicle inspections and report any issues to the program coordinator as needed
- Knowledge and willingness to assist wheelchair riders in embarking and disembarking
- Manage bookings, coordinate pick-ups and plan travel route
- Keep records of mileage, passengers and other necessary documentation
- Assist with managing database through new client entry and reporting service moments
- Provide program coordinator with feedback regarding shutting outings and ridership
- Promote SVNH services and programs that may improve passengers quality of life and decrease social isolation
