The South Vancouver Early Years’ Table is currently seeking a skilled **“Success in South Vancouver” Family Resource Programmer** to oversee a new project to support young children and their families in South Vancouver.

The “Success in South Vancouver” Family Resource Programmer is responsible for designing programming to support healthy outcomes for children 0-5 in South Vancouver through targeted outreach to vulnerable families. The position will establish a peer-to-peer referral system to connect isolated households with young children to neighbourhood services, and supervise/support ECE summer staff in operating “pop up” family drop-in programs at local parks. This position will report to the Director of Community Programs at South Vancouver Neighbourhood House, and is accountable to the South Vancouver Early Year’s Table.

The successful candidate will:

- Plan, implement and supervise Summer “Pop-Up” Parks Family Resource Program at 2-4 local parks in South Vancouver
- Supervise ECE staff to plan and deliver family and child-oriented activities
- Create and provide a warm, welcoming and supportive environment for families with children at 2-4 local parks in the summer of 2018
- Connect with isolated families over the summer and throughout the rest of the year
- Recruit, train and supervise peer-to-peer volunteer program
- Arrange two additional training sessions for peer-to-peer volunteers
- Support parents and caregivers in parenting issues and provide information and referral with a strengths-based approach
- Provide parent / family support and education on a one-to-one basis or in a group setting.
- Work collaboratively as part of the South Vancouver Early Year’s Table to identify community needs
- Maintain a thorough knowledge of community resources to meet families’ needs.
- Collect, evaluate and reports on relevant statistics to the program

Skills and Qualifications:

Post-secondary education in Family Support, Social Work, Counselling and/or a combination of education and related experience working in the field.

- Experience in the community social service sector with a demonstrated knowledge of community based programs.
- Appropriate personal and professional boundaries and a commitment to ethical service standards.

- Working knowledge and understanding of issues and concerns affecting families with young children.
