Job Overview:

The Community Food Programmer plays a key role in implementing and delivering various food skills programs located in Victoria-Fraserview/Sunset/and Killarney. S/he is also actively engaged in planning, developing, coordinating and evaluating the programs and community development objectives. This temporary position is for a 7 month maternity leave with the possibility for the position to be extended for up to a year.

Specific areas of responsibility include:

- 1. Provide leadership to the South Vancouver Food Network & facilitating changes through multiple collaborations that strengthen food security programming across South Vancouver.
- 2. Plan, organize and lead community kitchens, food and multicultural events, and deliver food skills workshops to various age groups
- 3. Plan, prepare and clean up after weekly meal for 30-40 people of diverse cultural backgrounds and ages
- 4. Develop funding proposals for food programs and identify new funding opportunities.
