South Vancouver Neighbourhood House (SVNH) is currently seeking an outgoing, organized, and dedicated Community Outreach Worker to support the South Vancouver Temporary Emergency Food Distribution Program at South Vancouver Neighbourhood House and Marpole Neighbourhood House.

South Vancouver (Killarney, Victoria-Fraserview, Sunset) and Marpole are Vancouver neighbourhoods with very limited food assets. Food security has been an ongoing issue in these neighbourhoods and has become far worse because of COVID-19. In order to respond to community needs, SVNH started providing emergency food support – both through food distribution at SVNH on Tuesday mornings and at Marpole Neighbourhood House on Thursday mornings, and through a hamper delivery program to vulnerable families.

As Community Outreach Worker, you will support the Program Coordinator with logistics and planning, purchase and storage of food, packaging and distribution of hampers, scheduling and deliveries, outreach, data collection and reporting, and wellness checks.

The successful candidate will:

- Work under the guidance and direction of the Office Manager / Food Distribution Program Coordinator to • support emergency food distribution in South Vancouver and Marpole.
- Engage with community members who are accessing emergency food support to build connections and support information and referrals.
- Support the scheduling and delivery of emergency food hampers to vulnerable families in South Vancouver and Marpole.
- Collect and maintains a participant data.
- Support wellness checks for community members. •
- Support communications initiatives including website and social media.
- Actively engage with community members and organizations to promote SVNH programs, services and • events. Maintain existing and develop new relationships.
- Provide excellent customer service, including timely and comprehensive responses to internal and external • inquiries.
- Offer reception and office coordination support.
