Peer Researcher Job Posting

South Vancouver Neighbourhood House (SVNH) is located on the unceded, occupied, ancestral and traditional homelands of the xʷməθkʷəy̓əm (Musqueam), Skwxwú7mesh (Squamish) and Səlilwətaʔ/Selilwitulh (Tsleil-Waututh) Nations. We recognize the vast cultural diversity of Indigenous people and acknowledge the heterogeneity of their opinions, representation, needs and desires.

South Vancouver Neighbourhood House (SVNH) is currently seeking two enthusiastic and compassionate Peer Researchers to provide support and conduct the City of Vancouver's Reduced Fare Transit Pilot Study.

Accountability:

Reporting to the Director of Community Programs, the Peer Researchers, in consultation with staff members and volunteers, will connect and recruit South Vancouver community members to become pilot participants for the Reduced Fare Transit Pilot study. The Peer Researchers will distribute transit passes to participants, conduct survey interviews, and participate in regular Advisory Committee Meetings. Each Peer Researcher will connect with the same 10 participants throughout the pilot, producing a total of 30 surveys and interviews per Peer Researcher.

Qualifications:

- Experience or education working in a non-profit or community setting
- Proven expertise in a multicultural setting; experience working with diverse and vulnerable populations and people with living experience of poverty
- Proven ability to build relationships and trust with community members; experience with trauma-informed practice or non-violent communication is an asset
- Understanding of equity, poverty and social justice issues
- Oral and written proficiency in English and another language represented in South Vancouver (Cantonese, Mandarin, Tagalog, Punjabi, Farsi, Vietnamese)
- Knowledge of community resources and services in South Vancouver area
- Computer literacy in Word, Excel, email and Internet
- Excellent and respectful interviewing skills
- Excellent organizational skills and ability to meet deadlines
- Critical thinking, problem solving, and conflict resolution skills
- Ability to work independently
- Successful criminal record search required
