(On contract) Job posting for Migrant Worker's Community Peer Navigator

South Vancouver Neighbourhood House (SVNH) is a community-based organization that focuses on connecting people and strengthening the neighbourhoods in South Vancouver. Neighbourhood Houses provide healthy places to live, work and play for residents of any age, from all walks of life. When you walk through the doors of SVNH, you find a unique and vibrant place where people can build their social connections by participating in wellness or cultural activities, or improve their personal capacity through volunteering, workshops, courses, and employment counselling. The sense of belonging people develop at a Neighbourhood House is enduring.

Job Description:

To use their life experiences to navigate the Canadian systems while working with migrant workers population. The peer navigator will play a unique role in understanding the needs of the migrant workers in various sectors to assess their need and help them connect with the SVNH Migrant Worker's Program. The contractor will also support the outreach peer navigators' network of the program as well. The contractor will work closely with the project lead/supervisor & the team. The project timeline is from November 15 to December 15, 2021.

Deliverables include:

- Outreach to migrant workers from the community (care workers, hospitality, farm, etc.)
- Support the migrant workers and help them connect with SVNH Migrant Worker's Program and other services.
- Work with the project supervisor and the team to facilitate the referral process of the project participants in-house and with external project partners
- Help facilitate the project evaluation process by distributing session feedback forms and overall project evaluation forms to participants
- Report to Project Supervisor

Qualifications:

- Has lived experience as a migrant worker
- Ability to complete reports
- Has passion, knowledge, and experience working with diverse community
- Ability to work in partnership with the project team, student, volunteers, and project partners
- The peer navigator is required to exercise sound judgement, sensitivity, and confidentiality
- Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing in English and another language
- Knowledge of MS Word, Excel, PowerPoint and or any other software
- Ability to work during weekday evening and weekend (if required)
- Multilingual as an asset (Tagalog, Spanish, Punjabi)
