South Vancouver Neighbourhood House (SVNH) is a community-based organization, located on the unceded territories of the Coast Salish people, that focuses on connecting people and strengthening the neighborhoods in South Vancouver (SV). We are seeking a **Community Engagement Programmer, Neighbourhood Equity and Representation** to support the team at SVNH to engage with residents in underserved parts of the region in new and unique ways. This is a new position that will contribute to SVNH's 2020-2023 strategic plan, specifically priorities related to **"Reframing South Vancouver"** and **"Connected Neighbourhoods"**.

SV comprised of three neighbourhoods – Killarney, Victoria-Fraserview, Sunset – is a diverse multicultural and multilingual area of Vancouver. SV is comprised of 80% visible minorities, 56% newcomers, and over 11% of the population with no English language knowledge. The languages of the racialized and underrepresented population in South Vancouver area include, but are not limited to, Arabic, Cantonese, Mandarin, Punjabi, Spanish, Tagalog and Vietnamese. SV is also an underserved in terms of social infrastructure and community assets. Transportation is limited and social isolation is a significant concern. This position will work with the Manager, Neighbourhood Equity and Representation, to support the teams across SVNH to create new ways for currently disconnected residents across SV to engage, participate, and increase their voice and agency.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Identify events that are happening in the neighbourhood; set up information booths, deliver information sessions to showcase SVNH and "Reframing South Vancouver" initiatives;
- Increase resident awareness and involvement in planning processes that impact the neighbourhood;
- Assist in the development of campaign materials (flyers, google/Facebook ad, twitter, Tiktok) and survey questions in the languages of the underrepresented population in SV (Cantonese, Mandarin, Punjabi, Tagalog, Spanish, Vietnamese, Arabic;
- Organize community events;
- Facilitate dialogues and community engagement processes that will deepen the shared understanding of the issues at hand;
- Engage with diverse communities: Indigenous leaders, racialized and underrepresented residents;
- Work alongside the Manager in tracking and reviewing engagement analytics, including social media, email marketing, media, program registrations to inform quarterly updates and marketing strategy;
- Assist in the recruitment and orientation of Engagement Volunteers and Advisory Committee Members;
- Engage in evaluation activities to extract testimonials, impact metrics and lessons learned to inform engagement strategies, and to strengthen organizational processes/content;
- Collate mapping undertaken (staff and residents) to get an accurate picture of natural neighbourhoods within South Vancouver; review all asset mapping documents;
