Generational Health is an interactive healthy living program for families with children ages 8-12. The Group Facilitator will be delivering the Generational Health curriculum to caregivers/parents and their children.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Attend refresher training workshop (returning staff) or full training workshop (for new staff) for program
- Participate in regular program delivery team meetings to support the ongoing implementation of the program
- Develop a thorough understanding of program delivery model and resources
- Support Program Coordinator with screening phone calls and registration
- Participate in quality assurance procedures
- Coordinate and deliver program sessions along with Physical Activity Facilitator and Program Assistant
- Participate in and support program evaluation activities, which may include providing evaluation documentation and focus group participation
- Performing related duties as required
